

WINDAROO LAKES LIGHTNING POLICY

When a lightning strike is detected within 10km of the club, play on the course and the use of the practice facilities will be immediately **SUSPENDED**. (Lightning Pro App set at 20km warnings).

- 1. The staff will text the field advising that "Play is suspended and all players MUST return to the Clubhouse"
- 2. One Staff member to inform players on front nine and one Staff member to inform players on back nine.
- 3. Staff to stop on the 6th Tee and 15th Green and simultaneously sound the siren for a long burst, which will indicate an immediate suspension. Staff to ask a Bar Staff member to also sound the siren.

Play will only resume when there have been no lightning strikes within 15km of the club in a period of at least 30 minutes. At this time, there will be two short blasts from the clubhouse siren to signify resumption of play.

Members, guests and visitors are reminded that when there is lightning in the area, they **MUST** return to the clubhouse **IMMEDIATELY**.

Please be aware that in the event that there is lightning in the vicinity, it may be so that the strikes have occurred without golfers being aware of them.

A reminder that the staff are under instruction – if there are golfers on course when there is lightning in the area, they must evacuate – they don't have a choice. Members may disagree with the policy, but that is not up to the staff to engage with them on that topic – it is a Club Policy that has been implemented by the Management.
